**BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS**



## 1. PERSONNEL

Dawne Boersen was appointed to the position of Elementary Principal effective February 1, 2010.

## 2. PRESENTATIONS

*Hockey Day in Stratford* - Superintendent of Education JoAnn MacGregor highlighted the events and activities that will be taking place on Wednesday, January 27 at St. Michael CSS in Stratford for all Stratford schools during Hockey Day in Stratford.

*2010 Canada's Outstanding Principals Award* - The Canadian Association of Principals partners with The Learning Partnership to award The Learning Partnership's 2010 Canada's Outstanding Principals Awards. These awards recognize the unique and crucial contribution that principals of publicly funded schools make to the community and to ensuring quality education for Canada's young people. J. MacGregor introduced and congratulated Joanne Lombardi, Principal of St. James Catholic School, Seaforth, who is one of thirty-two 2010 Canada's Outstanding Principals to receive the award. The Gala Awards Dinner for Canada's Outstanding Principals takes place in Toronto on February 23, 2010 at the Delta Chelsea Hotel.

## 3. EDUCATION

*Early Learning Program* - J. MacGregor and D. Boersen discussed the Early Learning Program which will provide a full day of learning to four and five year olds as part of the province's plan to build a stronger school system and a well-educated workforce. The program will be phased-in over time, starting in September 2010 at two of our Catholic elementary schools - St. Joseph's, Clinton and St. Ambrose, Stratford.

*E-learning Homework Help Resource Teacher* - The Ministry of Education has chosen to offer the Huron-Perth CDSB the opportunity, and the funds, to pilot the position of E-Learning and Math Homework Help Contact. Huron-Perth is one of 15 boards piloting this resource. Andrea Leroux, a math, geography, and guidance teacher, has been appointed. Superintendent of Education Dan Parr welcomed and introduced Andrea to the meeting. Andrea provided details of her new role which will be to help students, parents, and teachers become more familiar with the resources of the eLearning Ontario, especially the online after-school math help that is available for grade 7 to 10 students.



*Revisions to Board Policy 3D:10: Progressive Discipline and Student Conduct* - In June 2008 the Ontario Legislature passed Bill 157, the *Keeping our Kids Safe at School Act*. The new legislation requires changes to Board policy 3D:10. D. Parr outlined the proposed revisions to the policy.

G. Thuss discussed the Ministry memos regarding capital updates and long-term financing arrangements for Good Places to Learn capital projects.
