2. EDUCATION

Full Day Kindergarten Program - Superintendent of Education JoAnn MacGregor provided an update on the Early Learning Program for 4 and 5 year olds. The Ministry of Education has committed \$200 million to Year One, with full implementation by 2015-2016. The Board will begin to implement Phase 1 of the initiative in September 2010 in two of our elementary schools - St. Joseph's, Clinton and St. Ambrose, Stratford.

Equity and Inclusive Education Draft Policy - Policy/Program Memorandum (PPM) 119 requires all school boards to adopt an Equity and Inclusive Education policy, including religious accommodations. Superintendent of Education Dan Parr stated that the new policy *Developing and Implementing Equity and Inclusive Education Policies in Ontario Schools*, replaces the *Anti-racism and Ethno Cultural Equity PPM*. The policy will be taken to the Board for approval once public consultation has taken place.

Leaders' Learning Council 2010-2011 - The Leaders' Learning Council (LLC) consists of Executive Council, Principals and Vice-Principals, Coordinators, and Manager. LLC meets monthly to address the work of strategic development, organization and implementation. D. Parr and J. MacGregor provided an overview of the LLC's format, goals and themes for the coming school year.

3. MANAGEMENT

The Board set the tuition fee rate for Non-Resident students for the 2010-11 school year at \$11,250 (Elementary) and \$12,500 (Secondary).

Operational Review Report - G. Thuss highlighted the results of the operational review that was conducted over three days in March 2010. The report was reviewed in four functional areas: Governance and School Board Administration; Human Resource Management and School Staffing/Allocation; Financial Management; and School Operations and Facilities Management. The report will be posted on the Board website.



Construction at St. Mary's School, Goderich - The Board will prepare a request for proposal for architectural services to design and construct the addition to St. Mary's, Goderich. The Board has been allocated \$468,026 towards the construction of a classroom to accommodate the Early Learning Program for September 2011.

Final Report Regarding 2010-2011 Budget – The Certificate of the Director of Education and Compliance Reports were filed with the Ministry of Education on July 12, 2010, which met the filing deadlines of July 31, 2010.

The Director of Education's Personal Staff Development Plan for September 2010 to June 2011 was approved.

- D. Parr and J. MacGregor provided information on the PD day happening on Sept. 2 at St. Anne's CSS.
- As a "Catholic Community of Caring", Huron-Perth Catholic will walk as one "united group" at the upcoming Terry Fox Run in Seaforth on Sunday, September 19. M.
