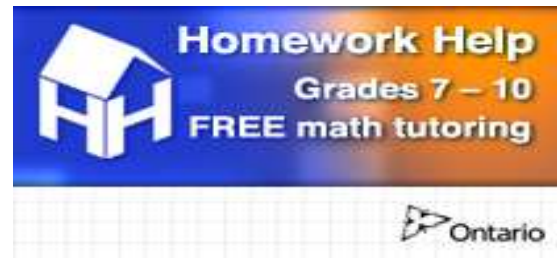


Homework Help

ONLINE MATHEMATICS HELP FOR
STUDENTS IN GRADES 7 - 10



Do you have a child in Grade 7 who doesn't quite understand fractions? Or maybe your teenager is struggling with a geometry assignment? Extra help is now available.

Check out [Homework Help](#), where certified Ontario teachers are online 20 hours a week to provide free math tutoring for all of our Grade 7 to 10 math students. Students in our board can log on and participate in a live one-on-one chat with a math teacher from 5:30 p.m. – 9:30 p.m., Sunday to Thursday.

Other math resources on the website include videos of teachers leading students through the top 20 most commonly asked math problems, interactive math tutorials, and highlights of best sessions. All students have a virtual locker, where their work is saved in video format for viewing anytime and access to a scientific calculator. These resources are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

"Many students continue to struggle with math. By expanding Homework Help, we are giving more students the extra help they need to succeed and graduate," explains Kathleen Wynne, former Minister of Education.
