1. Declare interest and file nomination forms before Friday, September 10, 2010 (2:00 p.m.)
2. Nomination papers should be filed with the appropriate municipal clerk.

Elections will take place on Monday, October 25, 2010

✧ Eligibility

The Education Act specifies that to be eligible to serve as a Catholic School Board trustee, you must be:

- a Roman Catholic
- a Catholic school supporter
- a resident within the jurisdiction of the Huron-Perth Catholic District School Board
- a Canadian citizen
- at least 18 years of age
