At its Annual Meeting of the Board on Monday, November 17, 2025, Mary Helen Van Loon was re-acclaimed to the position of Chair of the Huron-Perth Catholic District School Board.

Beginning her service to the Board as a Trustee in 2017, Ms. Van Loon enters her sixth consecutive term as Chair of the Board. Ms. Van Loon represents the areas of Perth South, St. Marys, and West Perth and serves the following schools: Holy Name of Mary, St. Marys and St. Patrick's, Dublin.
