THE HURON-PERTH CATHOLIC DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD SEEKS VOLUNTEER CATHOLIC COMMUNITY MEMBER TO SERVE ON ITS AUDIT COMMITTEE

The Huron-Perth Catholic DSB is seeking one (1) volunteer Catholic ratepayer to serve on its Audit Committee for a three (3) year term effective November 1, 2026.

The Audit Committee is composed of two (2) Trustees and two (2) independent members drawn from the community at large. The primary role of the Audit Committee is to assist the Board of Trustees in fulfilling its duties related to governance and oversight. The duties of the Audit Committee fall under the following key areas: the financial reporting process; internal control framework; risk management practices; performance and function of the Board's internal and external auditors; and the Board's compliance with its obligations under legislation. The Committee meets at least three (3) times a year, plus ad hoc meetings as required.

Candidate Eligibility:

- Must have sufficient accounting, senior financial management or legal expertise to understand public sector accounting and auditing standards.
- Must not be a current employee or officer of the Board, or of any other district school board or school authority.
- Must not have a parent, child or spouse currently employed by the Board.
